

Performing Arts Venue Restroom Survey



Have you ever stood in a long line for the restrooms at intermission of a show and thought, “why aren’t there more stalls here?!” Although most performance venues comply with applicable codes, too often restroom fixture counts fall short of meeting real-world demand.

The American Society of Theatre Consultants (ASTC) Subcommittee on Restrooms is using this survey as a way to gather a sample set of data to inform restroom space planning guidance for spaces of assembly. We plan to analyze current fixture counts, capacity, and adequacy of public restrooms in performing arts facilities of all types and sizes.

To help streamline your participation in this important survey, we have provided this print-out to help you log the restrooms in your venue. We will be asking about the following restroom types:

- Men's (toilets, urinals, accessible stalls)
- Women's (toilets, accessible stalls)
- All Gender (if applicable; toilets, urinals, accessible stalls)
- Private Occupancy (family/adult changing of unspecified gender)
