## <u>Business</u>

- 1. Meeting to order Peter Rosenbaum (PR)
  - a. The meeting was called to order at 11:02AM.
- 2. Committee Reports
  - a. Conference Heather McAvoy (HM)
    - i. Committee report review. See published report for details.
